Year 8

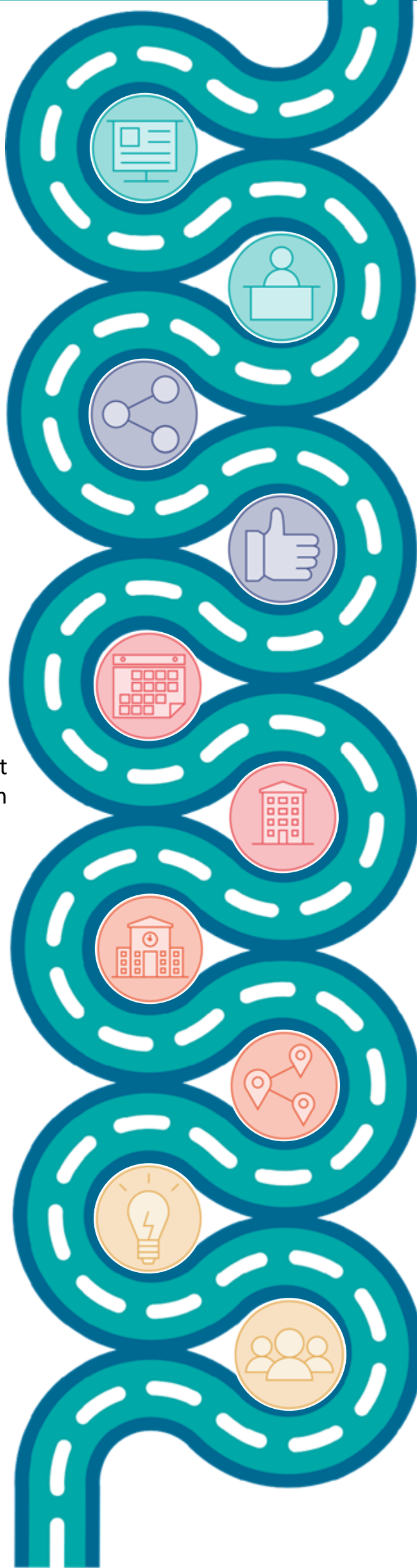
Focus: Proud To Be Me
